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## A. Overview

This guideline is for applicants who would like to apply for the exchange programs to our partner universities (except for Mainland China).

## B. Eligibility : Please refer to “國立臺灣海洋大學學生赴國外修施行細則”(Appendix 2)

(A) Applicants have to be enrolled at NTOU from the beginning of the application to the end of the exchange program.

(B) Undergraduate students have to be approved by their department. Graduate students have to be approved by their supervisors and their department.

(C) NTOU Language requirements

1. English : Please choose one of the followings to submit.

- TOEFL(iBT) 60 and above
- IELTS(academic) 5.0 and above
- TOEIC 600 and above

2. Japanese : JLPT N3 and above

3. Korean : TOPIK 3 and above

4. Others : Please refer to “國立臺灣海洋大學學生赴國外研修要點”(Appendix 1)

*\*Please make sure the language proficiency you submit is equivalent to NTOU and the host university if the partner universities' requirement is different with the NTOU's.*

(D) Applicants' last semester average academic score should be 60 and above.

*\*Please also meet the academic requirement as the partner universities ask.*

(E) If your exchange study has been supported financially by the Taiwan government or NTOU, you could not apply for the scholarship for the exchange program.

## C. Details related to the Exchange Programs :

(A) Duration of the semesters :

Also, some of the universities would have 3 semesters in one academic year. The above information is only for reference. Please follow the academic calendar to arrange for your schedule.*

(B) Please refer to the Appendix 3 “List of the Partner Universities' Student Exchange Program” to

know the quota, requirements and other details.

- (C) Applicants have to confirm that the program or department they apply is suitable for them. After the internal screening result announced, applicants can't ask OIA to change the nomination.

Prospective applicants are advised to visit the websites of individual schools for further details.

#### D. Internal Screening Information :

- (A) Deadline : from now to 12:00(noon) **May 10<sup>th</sup>, 2024 (Friday)**

The method of submission for every documents will be indicated in (C). Some would be in original ones, and others would be in digital ones.

The subject of the email is "Your name - Application for 2024 Exchange Program." Please make an appointment with the coordinator to submit the other documents in the same email. The office hour in NTOU is from 9:00 to 17:00, from Monday to Friday.

[STEP 2]

Please come to OIA at the appointed time. We'll check all your documents and discuss the **Preference** with you to ensure everything is as request. We highly suggest you to come here in person.


[STEP 3]

After accepting your applications, we'll send you a **confirmation email**. Please note that the application which are not submitted by the specific methods or submitted after the deadline won't be accepted. We'll return the documents if they are not accepted.

\*It would be highly suggested that submitting all the application as soon as possible. Because you would have enough time to correct or modify your documents if it is needed.

\*If there is any question or concern that you might have, please contact the coordinator without hesitation.

(B) Procedures :



(C) Application Package : All the documents should be presented as your first preference.

**Hard Copies:** Please use **A4** size, and print with **single side**. There is no need to bind your application package. You only have to collect them as the order below.

**Scanned Copies:** Please use **PDF format** and email to [marberthsu@email.ntou.edu.tw](mailto:marberthsu@email.ntou.edu.tw)

We'll reject the application package which is not completed as the instruction.

1. **Checklist** : Please use the format and submit the **hard** one.
2. **Application form** : Please use the format. It should be print as one A4 page. We won't accept modified format. We'll suggest you to type by the computer and print it out. Then, don't forget to sign on it and submit the **hard** one.
  - No matter the applicants' age is under or over the legal requirement, applicants have to ask their parents or guardian to sign on the application. If it is hard to do that, please contact OIA to discuss about the alternative.
  - Undergraduate applicants' application has to be stamped by their department and college. We won't accept the application without the stamps.

- Graduate applicants' application has to be stamped by their supervisor, department and college. We won't accept the application without the stamps.
3. **Original Academic transcript**(including the original scores, ranking and percentage) : Please apply for it from the Division of Registration and Curriculums (at the 3<sup>rd</sup> floor of the administration building) and submit the **hard** one.
    - Undergraduate applicants have to submit the transcript including all undergraduate semesters.
    - Graduate applicants have to submit the transcripts including undergraduate and graduate semesters.
    - Transfer students have to submit the transcript issued by NTOU and the previous university.
  4. **Language Proficiency** :
    - Please submit the language proficiency by the **digital** one.
    - Our partner universities in the US, Canada and France could not accept TOEFL(iBT) My Best Score and/or the examination which was taken 2 years before. If there is another university has the same regulation, we would make an announcement for our students as reference.
    - If the applicants have had the examination and had the scores online but haven't received the formal transcript or certificate, applicants can use the screen shot photo as an alternative. Please do not forget to re-submit the copy of formal certificate when the applicants received.
  5. **Autobiography** : The sample is for your reference. It is not mandatory to submit it as the sample format. Please submit the **digital** one.
  6. **Study Plan** : The sample is for your reference. It is not mandatory to submit it as the sample format. Please submit the **digital** one.
  7. **Application for Financial Support** : Please refer to the sample, use the designed format and submit the **digital** one.
    - It will be regard as the applicants give up applying for the scholarship if they don't submit the application for financial support along with the application package.
  8. **Preference and Confirmation** : Please use the designed format and submit the **hard** one. It is no need to submit if you apply for the non-partner universities.

**【How to complete the Preference and Confirmation】**

- Please refer to Appendix 2 to fill in this form. The no.1 preference means the university and department/program you would like to study most. Each applicant can choose no more than 5 preferences.
- Choose one department or program at the same university.
- For example :

No.	University	Department/Program

- Because applicants only can choose one department or program at the same university, the no. 2 preference will be regard as invalid. It will be replaced by the no.3 preference.
- OIA will check applicants' preferences one by one. If applicants' eligibilities are not as the partner universities ask, the preferences will be regard as invalid.

9. **Copy of ID Card or ARC Card** : Please make the front and back in the same file and submit the **digital** one.
10. **Other Documents** : e.g. portfolio, certificates and etc. (Please provide those you obtain during your undergraduate and graduate times.) If you have financial concerns, please provide the related proof. It will be regard as the reference for the scholarship. Please submit the **digital** one.

(D) Internal Screening :

1. Document Check : OIA will check applicants' eligibilities and application package. We'll reject the application if the applicants' eligibilities are not as required or any documents of the application package is missing or is not completed.
2. Interview : The committee composed of the representatives from each college will interview the applicants. The will take the parts below into considerations.

- (E) Principles of the Distribution : After the interview, the committee will confirm the result (nomination) by each applicant's scores and preference. The committee will refer to the language and preference order if applicants have the same scores. If the language and the preference order are the same, the committee will discuss and make the final decision.

**E. Notification :**

(A) During the Application Procedures

1. Students who passed the internal screening will be nominated to the partner universities, but the partner university has the right to admit or decline the application after the evaluation at their side. Students whose nominated status will be revoked if they can't obtain the acceptance from the partner university and/or the student visas. If there are scholarships involved, that will also be revoked.
2. After the distribution, students are not allowed to change the nominated status. If the admitted campus, department or exchange period is not up to expectations, students must decide whether to accept or withdraw their eligibility. **Please note that students who renounce the nominated status will not be accepted to apply for the exchange program before they obtain the current degree.**
3. If the exchange quotas and requirements alter accordingly due to the partner universities' regulations, students must accept this without any objections.
4. The partner universities do not have the responsibility of providing campus dormitories. Students must apply for dormitories in accordance to host university's regulations. If the host university doesn't provide the housing or students didn't apply for dormitories as

required, students have to arrange for their own accommodations. The host university and OIA carries no responsibilities in this aspect.

5. Exchange student should apply for a revocation of admission to the OIA if they are unable to join in the exchange program. Punishments are in accordance with school regulations if students withdraw without apparent reasons and cause issues between both NTOU and the host university.

#### (B) After Being Accepted by the Host University

1. After receiving the acceptance letter from the host university, exchange students have to contact the embassy to confirm how to apply for the student visa. Exchange students are responsible for their passport, visa and the transportation to the host university. If there are any difficulties, OIA will provide assistance within the scope of our responsibility. **Please note that OIA won't assist in the purchase of flights and the application for the passport and student visa.**
2. Exchange students are required to purchase their own insurance from the day of departure until the day of arrival in Taiwan (which includes medical, accidental, overseas rescue, etc.). Students should send OIA the copy of their insurance policy. OIA can revoke the admission if students don't purchase the required insurance.

#### (C) During the Exchange Program

1. Exchange students have to complete the registration and pay for the tuition to NTOU during the exchange period. Even the host university waiver all of partial tuition, students still have to be responsible for their personal living expenses. (Please note that some host university will ask students to pay for the miscellaneous expense. It is mandatory to pay for it because it is not the tuition.)
2. During the exchange period, students are prohibited from applying for graduation or suspension at NTOU, as well as accumulating leave exceeding 7 days. Violations of these regulations will result in the revocation of exchange status and scholarship. Additionally, students will be required to return all scholarship funds received. In the event of unforeseen circumstances (excluding participation in graduate school admission exams), students should promptly contact the Office of International Affairs in NTOU.
3. During the exchange period, students have to obtain the consents from both universities if he or she would like to suspend the exchange with any special changes.
4. After registration at the host university, students should abide by the university's regulations. Student shall not take part in situations that will damage both universities' reputation. If any violations are made, student will accept the punishment set by the rules from both universities.
5. The host university has the right to revise the courses they announced. The courses might be revised or cancelled due to some considerations.
6. During the exchange period, student have to stay in close contact with their family, OIA, the host university and pay attention to the safety issues.
7. Students have the responsibilities and obligations to promote NTOU by participating in related activities organized by the host universities such as exchange student fairs.
8. After the exchange program, exchange students must return to NTOU and continue their

studies in their original department to obtain the degree.

9. Exchange students are not allowed to extend their exchange period without NTOU and the host university's approval. Students who would like to extend the exchange period have to contact OIA **within one month after the beginning of the semester** at the host university.

#### (D) Obligations

1. The exchange student should discuss credit transfer matters with respective offices (e.g. departments, General Education Center, Physical Education Office and etc.) before leaving to the partner university. When returning to NTOU, please follow the regulations as the respective offices ask to do the credit transfer. Credits obtained from partner universities are not guaranteed to be calculated the same as NTOU. If both universities use different methods of calculation, causing the student to lose out certain credits, OIA will not be able to provide evidence for the student and will not have the responsibility to help the student strive for credits. If student is unable to graduate due to credit problems, the student should take responsible for all the consequences.
2. Exchange students have to abide by the course selection requirement as the host university asks. Students have to take at least one academic course if the host university does not set any requirement.
3. Exchange students awarded by the scholarship have to submit the Experience Report (1,500-2,000 words), the Questionnaire and 5 Photos to OIA within two weeks after being back to Taiwan. NTOU is entitled to disclose any information on that report on websites or provide use to relevant activities without the students' consent. Exchange students also have to complete the reimbursement procedures within four weeks after being back to Taiwan.
4. Exchange students have the obligations to assist OIA to promote the related programs.

#### (E) Others :

1. Students who renounce the nomination or admission could not apply for the program again within the same degree.
2. The internal screening result can be regard as the nomination order for the [Japan-Taiwan Exchange Association Scholarship \(for short-term exchange\)](#).
3. **Duo to the spread of the COVID-19, partner universities has the right to suspend or cancel the programs. Applicants have to abide by the official announcements.**
4. OIA reserves the rights to revise or update this guideline as necessary.

- 一、為配合學校永續發展、促進國際合作，鼓勵本校各系、所、中心遴選優秀人才赴國外大學、研究單位或企業等機構交流與學習汲取先進國家經驗，培育具國際競爭力之學生，特訂定本要點。
- 二、研修類型：
  - (一)雙聯學位
  - (二)赴姐妹校交換
  - (三)短期研修
- 三、本要點所稱之機構如下：
  - (一)與本校建有合作關係之學術單位或企業機構。
  - (二)經本校專案簽准之國外知名大學、研究單位或企業機構。
- 四、申請人應符合下列條件：
  - (一)申請人於申請期間與赴國外研修期間皆應為本校註冊生，且非為大一上學期之新生或當學期畢業之學生。
  - (二)大學部學生須經就讀系所主管同意；研究所學生須經指導教授及就讀系所主管同意。
  - (三)申請人須提交符合校內規定之「留學國語文能力證明」，各項語言能力證明標準如附件 1；申請赴大陸地區者得免提送；申請實習者，依各實習計畫規定辦理。
- 五、申請時間依研修類型施行細則而定。
- 六、申請方式：
  - (一)雙聯學位申請：依本校與國外學校辦理跨國雙學位實施辦法辦理。
  - (二)姊妹校交換及短期研修：依本校學生赴國外研修施行細則辦理。
- 七、本要點經行政會議通過後發布施行。

一、國立臺灣海洋大學學生赴國外研修施行細則(以下簡稱本細則)係依據國立臺灣海洋大學學生赴國外研修要點訂定之。

二、研修類型：

- (一) 赴姊妹校交換：研修期程為一學期(含)以上。
- (二) 短期研修：含短期研修學分、交換研究、遊學、實習…等。

三、申請資格：

(一) 符合本校「選送學生赴國外研修要點」：

1. 申請人於申請期間與赴國外研修期間皆應為本校註冊生，且非為大一上學期之新生或當學期畢業之學生。
2. 大學部學生須經就讀系所主管同意；研究所學生須經指導教授及就讀系所主管同意。
3. 申請人須提交符合校內規定之「留學國語文能力證明」；申請赴大陸地區者得免提送；申請實習者，依各實習計畫規定辦理。

(二) 符合欲申請計畫之申請條件(含語言能力要求)。

(三) 申請姊妹校交換者，申請之前一學期學業平均須及格以上。

(四) 如已獲我國政府或本校提供補助者，不得以同一出國研修計畫申請本施行細則補助。

(五) 餘依相關簡章、公告或規定辦理。

四、申請時間：依各計畫規定期程辦理。

五、申請文件：

(一) 赴姊妹校交換：

1. 本校學生赴國外研修申請表
2. 歷年成績單(註明系排名百分比)
3. 外國語言能力證明(赴大陸地區者得免提供；申請實習者，依各實習計畫規定辦理)
4. 身分證正反面影本
5. 自傳
6. 讀書計畫
7. 其他有利審查文件

(二) 短期研修：依簡章提交本校學生赴國外研修申請表及相關文件，並完成核章程序後提交國際事務處辦理。

#### 六、審核原則：

(一) 赴姊妹校交換：由國際處進行書面審查，視必要情形得召開選送學生赴國外短期研修甄選委員會會議，依下列原則審核之。

1. 國外姊妹校：依據外語能力（30%）、在校成績(30%)、研修計畫及其他輔助文件(40%)進行評比，決定推薦及獎補助之優先順序。
2. 大陸地區姊妹校：依據在校成績(45%)、研修計畫及其他輔助文件(55%)進行評比，決定推薦及獎補助之優先順序。

(二) 短期研修：依相關簡章、公告或規定辦理。

#### 七、獎補助項目及數額：

(一) 赴姊妹校交換：

1. 經濟艙機票費。
2. 學費補助(如已獲姊妹校學費減免者，則不再予以補助)：
  - (1) 赴國外姊妹校者：原則上補助該校學費總額百分之五十，不得高於新臺幣八萬元。
  - (2) 赴大陸地區姊妹校者：學費全額補助，但不得高於本校學費之百分之八十。
3. 生活費（依公費留學生請領公費項目及支給數額一覽表計算）。
4. 各姊妹校減免項目依兩校簽署之學術交流合作協議內容辦理。

(二) 短期研修學生：依相關簡章規定辦理。

(三) 獲教育部學海系列計畫獎補助者，依「國立臺灣海洋大學學海系列計畫補助施行細則」核給補助。

(四) 如已獲本施行細則獎補助者，不得以同一出國研修計畫申請我國政府或本校提供之其他出國補助。

八、經費來源：校外獎助學金及本校五項自籌收入等。

#### 九、相關規定與義務：

(一) 本選送學生赴國外研修甄選委員會由國際長(或副國際長)及各學院推薦代表各一人所擔任，為無給職。開會時應有全體委員二分之一(含)以上出席方得開會，會議得視需要邀請相關行政單位或教學單位代表列席。

(二) 獲推薦之學生於國外研修期間之學籍、學業及兵役等事宜，依本校學則及中華民國相關法令辦理。

(三) 獲推薦參加交換計畫之學生，須遵守姊妹校之修課規定，如姊妹校無特殊規定者，須修習至少一門專業課程。

(四) 赴姊妹校交換學生須於完成研修後一個月內返國。若有具體理由或不可抗力之情事須提前結束交換計畫者，須先取得兩校同意，不得自行終止及返國。

(五) 如獲獎補助，返國後兩周內須依指定格式繳交1,500~2,000字心得報告至國際事務處(得由本處自行運用)，並協助推動宣傳本計畫；另於返國後四周內須依規定完成核銷。

(六) 獲推薦之學生若無故放棄，於同一學制內不得再針對同一計畫提出申請。

十、本細則經行政會議及校務基金管理委員會通過後發布施行。
